Purpose of Comprehensive Planning

- Provides a firm foundation for policy and action that allows a county to function more efficiently and effectively
- Strengthens the County's policies and regulations
- > Addresses current problems and issues
- Helps create a more desirable and certain future
- ➤ Authorized by South Dakota Codified Law (Chapter 11-2)

11-2-12. Purposes of comprehensive county plan.

- To protect and guide the physical, social, economic, and environmental development of the county;
- To protect the tax base;
- To encourage a distribution of population or mode of land utilization that will facilitate the economical and adequate provisions of transportation, roads, water supply, drainage, sanitation, education, recreation, or other public requirements;
- To lessen governmental expenditure; and,
- To conserve and develop natural resources.

Benefits of Comprehensive Planning

Provides guidance for future decision-making by elected officials and county staff.

Makes land use regulations stronger and less susceptible to legal challenges.

Provides residents or developers advanced knowledge of the intentions of the County.

Strengthens eligibility of grant and funding applications for public infrastructure improvements.

= Positive Future Growth & Change

Comprehensive Plan

What it is:

- A collection of information and materials designed to guide future development
- Also known as a general plan or master plan
- Typically includes a future land use map and other visuals
- Easy to read
- Updated regularly to reflect changing conditions
- A "to do list" or "road map" used to create a more desirable future

is Not What it

- Strict plan for regulating development
- Zoning Ordinance
- Zoning Map
- Subdivision Regulations
- Capital Improvement Plan
- Building or Fire Codes
- These are specific documents intended to help implement the vision and goals of the comp plan

Comprehensive Planning Involves

- ✓ Analysis of past, current, and anticipated future conditions
- ✓ Public input about the needs and desires of the County
- ✓ Visioning and goal-setting, as well as policies and strategies for achieving a collective vision and goals
- ✓ Careful consideration of the County's future growth and development (~10 years into the future)





Larger than Rhode Island and Delaware combined (3,196 sq mi)









Meade County Population




Housing Cost-Burdened

27% - Meade County 22% - South Dakota


More than 30% of household income is spent on housing costs

Lawrence & Pennington = similar %


Meade County Income
